

# things to do

- Karijini National Park - Awesome Natural beauty in the gorges, waterfalls and cool swimming holes, walking trails and picnic areas.
- Visit Millstream Chichester National Park - Features a number of freshwater pools, including the pretty Chinderwarriner Pool, Crossing Pool, Deep Reach Pool and the Python Pool, bushwalking and scenic drives.
- Jaburara Heritage Trail - A 3.5 kilometre walk highlighting the Karratha districts natural history and cultural heritage and in particular its traditional inhabitants, the Jaburara Aboriginal Tribe.
- Hearsons Cove - Popular swimming and picnic/barbecue spot, located on the Burrup Peninsula between Karratha and Dampier. Great location to see the 'Stairway to the Moon' which occurs when there is a full moon between the months of May through to October.
- Six Mile Railway Museum - Mid-way between Karratha and Dampier, housing the 'Pendennis Castle' express steam loco, the early Pilbara diesel-electric locomotives and other items of railway interest.
- Miaree Pool - Lovely spot for picnics, swimming or just laying around under the wonderful shade trees that grow right on the water's edge.
- Visit Historic Cossack - Approx 50km from Karratha. Cossack was once the bustling harbour for the early pearling industry before it relocated to Broome. The municipality of Cossack was dissolved in 1910, although people continued to live there until after World War II. Today Cossack offers a unique look at our colonial past, with nine of the original buildings fully restored.

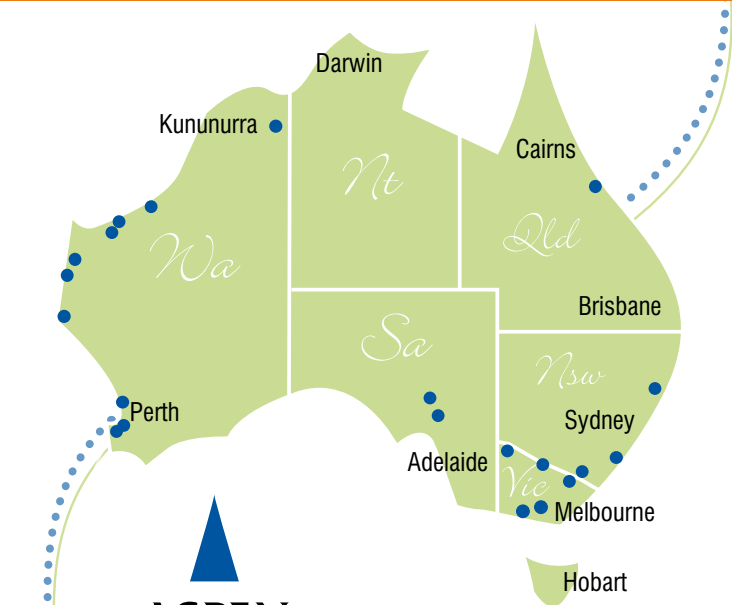
# welcome

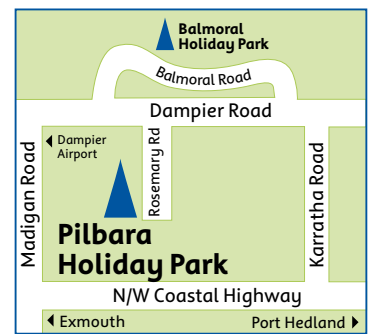

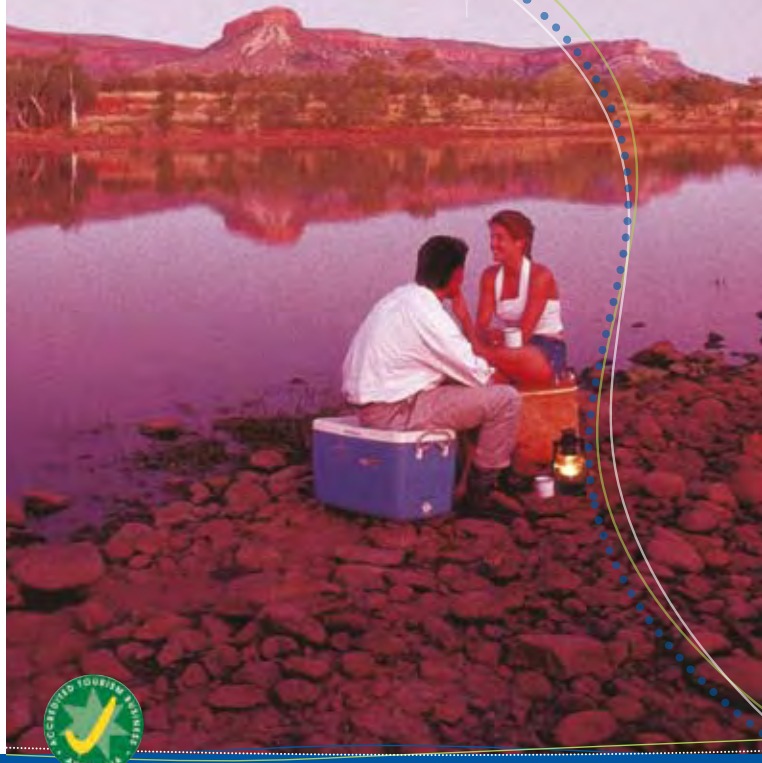
